*Supplement to Motion* - Resolution No. 2017-22 identifying Salem as an Inclusive City.

**MOTION:**

Move that City Council:

1. Suspend Council Rule 5(j) to allow Council to vote on Resolution No. 2017-22 as revised, and
2. Adopt Resolution No. 2017-22 as revised.

**DISCUSSION:**

*City Attorney's note:* After this motion was included in tonight's agenda for Council's consideration, Councilor Andersen submitted modifications to the proposed resolution. Pursuant to Council Rule 5 (j) a motion must be submitted in writing prior to 9:30 am the Tuesday prior to the council meeting in order for the item to be acted on by Council at that meeting, unless Council elects to suspend its rules. Council may temporarily suspend its rules by a two-thirds vote of members present.

The resolution has been revised to modify one of the recitals;

"Whereas, Discrimination based on national origin, race, ethnicity, language, gender identity, sexual preference, marital status, disability, income, citizenship status, ~~or~~ religion or perceived national origin is a chronic aspect of life for immigrant and refugee populations of Oregon;"

and to add a new section 4;

**"Section 4.** The use of City funds, personnel or equipment for the enforcement of any federal law enforcement that targets people based on their religion, race, ethnicity, country of origin, language, gender identity, sexual preference, marital status, disability, income, and citizenship status is prohibited."
